US Army Intelligence officer with 6 years of service including 5 deployments. Sarah is pursuing an MBA at the Tuck School of Business at Dartmouth College thanks to the GDMF.

Sarah graduated from the United States Military Academy in 2007 and commissioned into the Army as a military intelligence officer. She served six years on active duty service in support of aviation units based out of Fort Campbell, Kentucky. Sarah deployed multiple times including five trips to Afghanistan as a task force member of the Army's Special Operations Aviation Regiment. In 2013, she transitioned from active duty and moved to California to begin a career in the wine world. Sarah continues to serve in the Army Reserves in strategic intelligence units. In 2019, Sarah decided to pursue a full-time MBA at the Tuck School of Business at Dartmouth College and she aspires to become a strategy leader in consulting or life-sciences. ZOSA IZE-IYAMU

US Navy SEAL with 10 years of service and 4 deployments. Ize is pursuing both an MBA from Harvard Business School and a Masters in Computer Science at Georgia Institute of Technology with assistance from the Glen Doherty Memorial Foundation. He was the guest speaker at the 2019 Winchester fundraiser, Cheers to Glen.

Izosa is the child of an immigrant parent and grew up in a handful of locations across the United States. He attended St. John's University from which he graduated magna cum laude with a B.S. in Computer Science. Deeply impacted by the attacks on 9/11, he joined the U.S. Navy in 2008 where he pursued a career in Naval Special Warfare. He completed BUD/S with class 278 in 2009 and was subsequently assigned to SEAL Team THREE (Glen's former team) where he completed deployments to Yemen and Afghanistan. In 2014, after six years of service, Izosa planned to transition into the reserve component and pursue an MBA through Harvard Business School. When it became evident that the ISIS threat would require American intervention, he declined his offer of admission and chose to remain in active duty service to help abate the proliferation of ISIS. His final two deployments were both to Iraq, where he led joint-service

US Navy SEAL, served 10 years. Close friend of Glen. Shane served as a Naval Special Warfare Combat Medic and Special Ops Combat instructor. Shane is currently in medical school at Rutgers University to become an MD thanks to the GDMF. He is also running the New York City marathon this November to support our scholarship fund!

US Navy SEAL with 10 years of service and 4 deployments overseas. Michael is a 2019 GDMF Scholar currently attending Harvard University pursuing a masters in Public Administration. He attended the 2019 fundraiser, Cheers to Glen in Winchester this March.
